## New science labs for our schools

The State Labor Government is building new advanced science and technology labs at schools across the state.

\$9 million in funding will be provided to schools in our community to improve education in vital science, technology, engineering and mathematics subjects.

These upgrades are to ensure our children have the skills they need for the new industries and jobs of the future – such as defence, technology, medical research and international education.

## Transformation of Port Adelaide to commence

The transformation of the historic maritime precinct of Port Adelaide into a thriving residential, commercial and tourist destination is set to continue under the proposed development of nearly 23 hectares of waterfront land.

# Transformation of **Port Adelaide** to commence

(Continued from page one.) Two Australian developers and a South Australian construction company, have been selected to develop five parcels of land on the inner harbour.

Our community wanted lower building heights, more public access and waterfront activities and this development will achieve these aims.

The proposals include nearly 1300 homes across four precincts including:

- 760 homes at Dock 1 and Port Approach developed by Starfish Developments. and;
- 500 homes in the North West and Fletcher’s Slip precincts developed by Cedar Woods.

A promenade around the inner harbour is proposed maintaining public access to the waterfront. The old Marine and Harbours building will be redeveloped into apartments and retail premises, as well as an observation deck and an outdoor cinema.



## Upgrading women’s sporting facilities

The State Government is addressing the lack of female change rooms by investing \$10 million to upgrade and build new female change rooms at sports clubs across SA.

Local construction jobs will also be created as sports clubs apply for the grant.



## Investment in the Port

The State Government will be investing \$12.2 million towards construction of a new building in Port Adelaide to bring more than 500 public sector workers into the Port. A further \$1.2 million over two years will be invested to promote economic development in the Port.



## Defence industry investment

The State Government will invest \$13.7 million to help South Australia achieve maximum economic benefit from the Future Submarine, Offshore Patrol Vessels and Future Frigate contracts.

This means more local jobs for our community.

# Jobs boost: \$10,000 grant for each new job created

One of my major priorities is to help businesses in our community create more jobs.

The State Government is providing a grant of up to \$10,000 for small and medium businesses for each new job created.

Due to a State Budget in surplus we are able to provide these grants to help businesses grow their workforce.

Businesses that pay payroll tax will receive \$10,000 per job, and very small or startup businesses will receive a \$4,000 grant per job.

We estimate these grants will provide 14,000 new jobs over the next three years.

We are also investing in science and innovation funding, in our defence industry and in campaigns to help promote local SA products.

## Expanding Adelaide's public transport network

Commuters will soon be able to catch the tram along North Terrace with a \$55 million upgrade delivering the first stage of the AdeLINK tram network.

The extension will help bring alive sites along North Terrace and provide a new transport option for travel to the city's East End.

For our local community this means easier access to the North Terrace universities, museums and State Library via the tram.



## More Police in our community

The State Government has provided a \$16 million boost to increase police numbers. These means there will be 313 new South Australian police officers on the street protecting our community.

With a bigger police force there will be an increasing number of officers focussed on critical and emerging crimes of domestic violence, cyber-crime and counter terrorism.



## Supporting SA Paramedics

An additional \$13 million has been provided to SA Ambulance Service.

This new funding represents a strong investment in health services within our local community and will improve the safety, efficiency and effectiveness of the staff that provide front line health care to South Australians.
